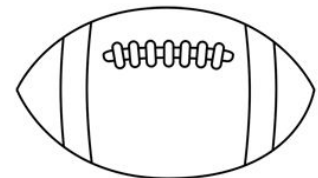
Mrs. Dunbar's Sports Report
