SAFETY AND ALICE TRAINING!!!

Good afternoon, everyone!

Living in the times that we do, it is necessary to have drills to keep our staff and students as safe as we possibly can during the event of an emergency. We routinely practice fire drills as well as other drills to help keep our students and staff safe. These drills are mandated by law and are part of school board policy. One of the main responsibilities and duties of a building principal is to make every effort to ensure the safety of students and staff at a school.

We take great care to not create drills or scenarios that would be scary and traumatizing to our students, while we also work to teach the kids how to be safe.

This year our district is using the ALICE safety procedures to help ensure the safety of our school. Some of the methods are different than the conventional lockdown methods. The acronym ALICE stands for:

- A= Alert**
- L= Lockdown**
- I= Inform**
- C= Counter**
- E= Evacuate**

Your student will be taught and will practice each of these components. They will know how to act and what it means for each action of the ALICE procedures. Below are some examples: students will know what an Alert sounds like and what they need to do; when to go into Lockdown and how to act; how to Inform others of the situation; how to use Counter measures if needed; when it is appropriate to Evacuate and how to evacuate.

We want all students and staff to be as safe as possible and know the routines and procedures to keep them safe. These procedures not only keep the child safe but help to ensure that all people in the classroom are kept safe by knowing the routines and procedures.

We will conduct two drills this spring. They are scheduled on the afternoons of March 27 and April 3. We will verify this next week. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact Mrs. Hudson or Mrs. Dunbar. Thank you for your continued support and feedback.
