Free Meals for all Students

The USDA has extended waivers to school districts so that all students get free meals no matter what their eligibility is. This will go through December 31, 2020 **or until they run out of funds.**

In-school and on-line students may get free breakfast and lunch. If you are an on-line student you may request pick up meals ahead of time from the school.

The district is asking parents to fill out a [free & reduced application form](#). This is critical information that is used for many grant opportunities in addition to free lunch. For grants and school count day, it is very important to have this form completed and returned before October 1, 2020. Also, the application will be needed in order for students to continue getting free lunch once the grant funds run out.

Inclement Weather

The time has come when students will need to be prepared for cooler weather. We will be outside as much as possible throughout this fall and winter so it is incredibly important that students come with appropriate clothing for cold weather. **We will be staying outside unless the temperature drops below zero degrees.** Students need to dress warmly during cold weather.
