## Go Bruins!!!

**Volleyball and Football** start official practice today. This is so great that we get to play, so it is incredibly important that we follow all the guidelines given to us by the district and the county health department.

### **Game day**

- All competitors, coaches and people who will be on the sidelines will have temperature check and symptom screening before they get on the bus to travel or enter the field or gym if home team
- These temperature checks and symptom screening will be performed by administration
- Each team will need to give the documentation of temperature and symptoms to the home team Athletic Director before the game can begin
- Any symptomatic students are not eligible to participate

### **Volleyball**

- Competitors will be required to wear a mask. When on the court in competition they may pull the mask down
- All competitors will be given two spectators tickets to attend each game
- We will not allow any spectators into the gym without a ticket
- Spectators will be required wear masks
- \$2 admission will be charged to help pay for officials and game workers
- Coaches will be required wear masks
- Spectators are asked to social distance at all times in the gym
- Only four teams of 12 will be allowed in the gym at one time

### **Football**

- Competitors will be required to wear a mask. When on the field in competition they may pull the mask down
- Coaches will be required wear masks
- Spectators are asked to social distance at all times
